Observations and Suggestions by the Internal Academic Audit Committee:

- 1. It is found that during the session student enrolment increased from that in the previous years in the conventional degree courses. However, the no of students admitted in the self-financed UG, PG, diploma and certificate courses have seen a decrease.
- 2. Some programmes of previous years like diploma in web designing, add on course on personality development and certificate course in fashion technology were discontinued during this academic year.
- 3. Though the course in Diploma Course in Tea Technology and Plantation Management is not discontinued, but there was no admission of student in this course during the session.
- 4. Pass percentage of students in B.Com course during the year is only 23.8 %.
- 5. Student enrolment and final year examination appearing ratio is not found to be in balance. This increases the possibility of increase in future dropout rates of the college.
- 6. Only one research project is on-going during the session by the faculties of the college. This needs to be enhanced.
- 7. Only three numbers of Seminars/Workshops was organized during 2021-22 by the college. This is fewer than the previous year averages.
- 8. It is highly recommended that the college arranges student career awareness and orientation programmes as well as placement drives in the next years since during this academic session not a single such program was organized by the college.
- 9. College should introduce more number of add-on courses in its curriculum since only three add on courses are being offed by the college for its students during the session.
- 10. Online grievance redress system needs to be introduced.
- 11. Organize coaching programmes for the students for various competitive examinations.
- 12. Alumni network of the college and their involvement needs to be enhanced in the college.
