Part - II Observations and Suggestions

No of Books:

It is observed that during the sessions 2018-19 and 2019-20 though the book stock in the library has increased significantly, the book student ratio has decreased since there was also significant increase in the number of student admitted in the college. Hence, to increase the book student ratio, significant increase in the number of books is of utmost importance.

Reading Room:

The library has an appreciable number of books with adequate infrastructure. During the summer months the reading room of the library becomes very hot and as such, for better comfort and convenience of the readers, air conditioning system may be introduced.

Journal and E Resources:

Since the newly introduced CBCS course at undergraduate level as well as post graduate courses stresses more on project based study, the library may consider subscribing printed research journals published by various academic institutions or subject based associations.

Moreover, the library may consider institutional membership of the online e-resources like- Springer, Elsevier, Science Direct, Taylor & Francis

Stack Area:

Dearth of space in the stack area is noticed. Necessary steps should be taken to enlarge the stack area.

Internet Speed:

Necessary arrangement should be done to enhance the internet speed of 1mbps which is slow by the contemporary standards.

Library Staff:

The number of present library staff does not seem adequate against its infrastructural set-up. Hence, the authority should take step to increase manpower

Book Borrowing from Other Library:

The college library already has Inter library Loan facility with Nowgong Girls' College since 2015 via MOU. The same may be extended to other institutions in the region.

Action taken on the Recommendations of Library Audit Committee

- 1. Books worth two lakh rupees were procured in January, 2021 to augment the stock of book and improve the book-student ratio.
- 2. Two routers were ordered for raising the internet speed in the library premises.
- 3. Proposals were submitted before governing body to install air-conditioners in the reading room and the manuscript section of the library.
- 4. Scientific journals like Springer were subscribed in 2021.
- 5. Augmenting the man-power of library could not be done as the post of staff has to be sanctioned by the government of Assam.
- 6. The college administration will take up with other local colleges to set up Inter library Loan facility.
