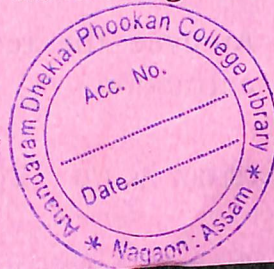

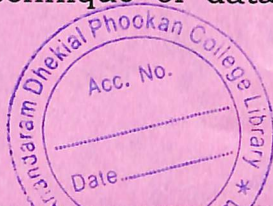
- (e) Name *one* Indian remote sensing satellite.
