

## Special facilities provided for women

### ADP College

ADP college facilitates special provisions for women. The college has particular cells for addressing issues related to girls and women and the college has been continuously working in that direction. The College has Anti-Ragging Committee, Students grievance redress cell and Gender Sensitization Committee against sexual harassment. The committee works hand in hand in fostering healthy interpersonal relations among students and addresses issues and provides them counseling and justice whenever required. The college has also installed CCTV in each classroom to monitor activities of students in the classroom. Apart from that, there is a well spaced common room for girls, which creates opportunities for students to interact and indulge in different activities. Moreover a sanitary vending machine is installed in the classroom to take care of the safety and security of the girls. The college also provides hostel facilities for the girls and ensures that those who are meritorious and economically weak get the first service. This is a step towards more and more enrollment of girls in the college.
