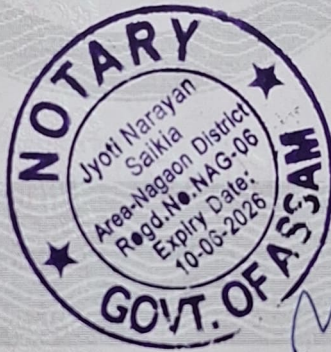

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MEMORANDUM OF ASSOCIATION

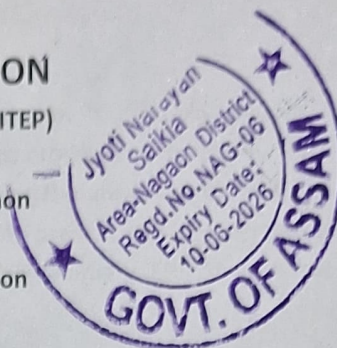
For Integrated Teacher Training Programme (ITEP)

A pivotal aspect of this vision is the Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP), which aligns with the broader goal of restructuring education. Presently, Assam faces challenges in Teacher Education (B.Ed.), particularly in terms of inadequate institutional infrastructure compared to the growing demand from students. To address this shortfall, the government has taken initiative to launch integrated B.Ed. courses by associating College of Teacher Education with select multidisciplinary institutions. 
REVIEW OF THIS MOU




