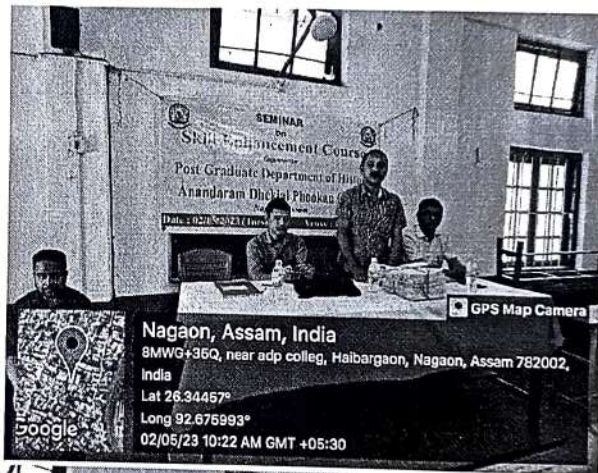

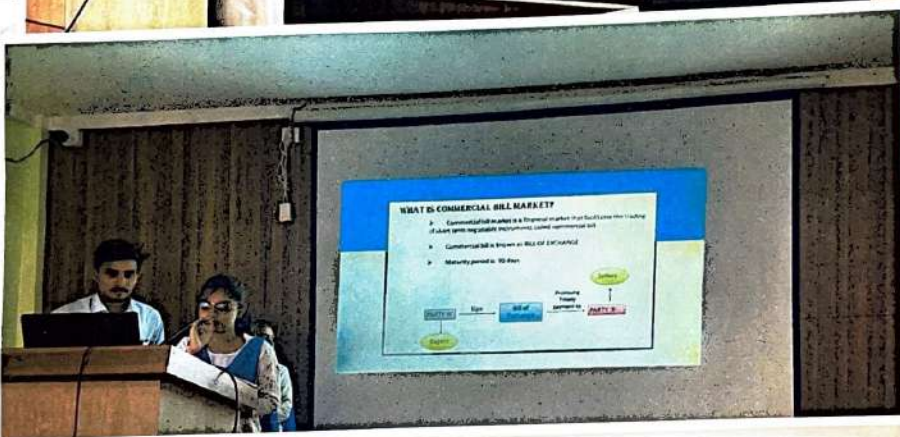
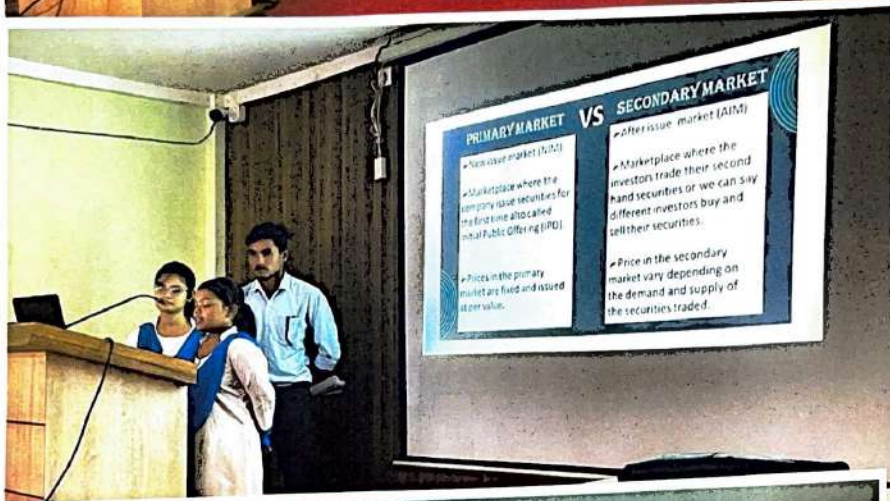
Topic: Money and Financial Markets.
