REPORT ON REMEDIAL COACHING

(Period 2023-2024)

The College organizes remedial coaching sessions specifically designed for students who face challenges in learning. The primary goal of these sessions is to help slower learners achieve the academic level of their peers.

The Cell for Remedial Coaching arranges these classes across various departments, targeting students who have difficult passing certain subjects or wish to strengthen their grasp of specific topics.

In an effort to reduce dropout rates and academic failures the cell was established in 2012 with financial support from the UGC (University Grants Commission) for remedial coaching at the undergraduate level. Though the UGC grant is no longer available, the departments continue to conduct remedial sessions to benefit students.

Objectives of Remedial Coaching:

- To enhance students' knowledge, skills, and attitudes in specific subjects through the
 use of appropriate teaching methods and guidance, ensuring they can pursue further
 studies effectively.
- To equip slower learners for success in competitive examinations.

The college consistency works to improve students' overall development, fostering skills beneficial for their academic and professional growth. Given the diversity of students admitted, needs and guide them in adapting to challenges. Faculty members mentor students, provide clarity on academic content, and encourage them to share ideas and actively participate in their development.

Departments Participation:

All the departments of the institution viz. Chemistry, Physics, Mathematics, Zoology, Botany, Geography, Statistics, Economics, Education, Political Science, Philosophy, Hindi, Assamese, Sanskrit, Bengali, Arabic, English, History, Commerce and Computer Science take their classes for respective subjects to improve the slow learners. And the students are grouped based on the total number of participants in each course, with each group limited to a maximum of 15 students.

Key Features of Remedial Classes:

- Remedial sessions are held after regular college hours on working days.
- Sessions are completed before the end-semester examinations begin.
- Periodic assessments are conducted to track students' progress.
- Model question papers are solved under the guidance of faculty to address doubts.






