"BASIC TECHNIQUES OF FIELD SURVEYING"

Course Objective:

This Add on course on "Basic Techniques of Field surveying" is designed to provide a general understanding of the field of survey and their application in the field of map making. The main objective of this course is to provide the learners with theoretical and practical training on different techniques through different surveying instruments for preparation of map/plan of the surveyed area.

A. Medicinal Plants Nursery Site

Unit 1: Types of nursery beds, propagation, tilting the soil, Good agricultural practices (GAP), Nursery management and post work activities

Unit 2: Propagation: Type of seed, Seed treatment protocols & agronomic practices Cuttings, layering and grafting
