### **“BASIC TECHNIQUES OF FIELD SURVEYING”**

#### **Course Objective:**

This Add on course on “*Basic Techniques of Field surveying*” is designed to provide a general understanding of the field of survey and their application in the field of map making. The main objective of this course is to provide the learners with theoretical and practical training on different techniques through different surveying instruments for preparation of map/plan of the surveyed area.

#### **Course Outcomes:**

- Understanding the importance of various surveying techniques
- General understanding of preparation procedures of different types of plans and map

#### **Part I: Theory**

- Surveying: Its meaning, types and significance (2 Hours)
- Techniques of surveying by Plane Table, Prismatic Compass, and Dumpy Level. (4 Hours)
- Methods of radiation, intersection, traversing, contouring and levelling in surveying. (4 Hours)
- GPS: Basic concept, principles and utilities (2 Hours)

#### **Part II: Practical**

(28 Class Hours)


- Preparation of a plan or a map of an area within the college campus or any suitable area using Plane Table (applying both radiation and intersection methods) (8 Hours)
- Open and Closed Traverse Surveying with Prismatic Compass: Preparation of plan along with adjustment of closing errors. (8 Hours)



- Profile levelling and contouring by Dumpy Level (8 Hours)
- Preparing a map of a short trail along with prominent features by using hand-held GPS. (4 Hours)



**Name of the Course: Medicinal Plant Grower**

**Type of the Course: Certificate Course**

Course duration: 30 hours

**Curriculum:**

**A. Medicinal Plants Nursery Site**

**Unit 1:** Types of nursery beds, propagation, tilting the soil, Good agricultural practices (GAP), Nursery management and post work activities

**Unit 2:** Propagation: Type of seed, Seed treatment protocols & agronomic practices Cuttings, layering and grafting

**Unit 3:** Cultivation management: Organic manures such as vermicompost, green leafy manure and bio-fertilizers Water management, Inter-cultivation practices Pest management

**B. Harvesting:**

**Unit 1:** Harvesting: Correct plant parts, good harvesting practices, Appropriate season and time for harvesting, maturity of plant and cutting techniques

**Unit 2:** Control measures to prevent contamination of harvested plant parts

**C. Post harvesting procedures**

**Unit 1:** Cleaning, dehydration, sorting and grading the harvests Isolation of toxic weeds using good agricultural practices, Storage, packaging and transport produce, labelling with all the required information and record keeping.

**Unit 2:** Market related activities of medicinal plants, Demand and supply of medicinal plants in the market, Target customers and their needs

**Unit 3:** Basic accounting: Information related to various subsidies; record keeping and key marketing channels. Safety checks before operation, Waste disposal Environmental damage, Emergency procedures

**D. Practical:**

1. Demonstration of nursery techniques: preparation of seed bed, cuttings bed, soil mix, layering, transfer to polybags, etc.
2. Cultivation of medicinal and aromatic plants e.g. Citronella, Lemon grass, Patchouli, etc.
3. Demonstration of tools, materials and methods used in nursery, cultivation, harvesting, packaging, storage and transport of medicinal plants.
