Mandatory Attendance for University Examination and Government Benefit Schemes

1. Eligibility to appear in the University Final Examination (as per University attendance requirements).
2. Continuation/renewal of benefits under the Fee Waiver Scheme (Free Admission).
3. Continuation of benefits under the Mukhya Mantrir Nijut Moina Aasoni (MMNMA).
4. Continuation of benefits under the Mukhya Mantrir Nijut Babu Aasoni (MMNBA).

Therefore, all students are strictly instructed to attend their classes regularly and maintain the prescribed minimum attendance. Failure to do so may result in ineligibility for the University examination and withdrawal of the above Government benefits.

EXECUTIVE ORDER

Sub: Scheme for Fee Waiver of admission fees, tuition fees etc. for students taking admission in H.S., BA/BSc/BCom and M.A./M.Sc./M.Com. Courses for the Academic Session 2026–27.

In continuation of the Fee Waiver Scheme under Pragyan Bharati for free admission in H.S., BA/BSc/BCom and M.A./M.Sc./M.Com. Courses under the Higher Education Department, Government of Assam, the scheme shall continue for the Academic Session 2026–27 for eligible students whose parental annual income is below Rs. 4.00 lakh from all sources.

Aim:

To provide access to higher education to economically disadvantaged students of the State and to support them in pursuing higher education without financial hardship.

1. Scope-

- i. The Scheme shall be applicable to eligible students seeking admission into the 1st year of H.S., B.A., B.Sc., B.Com. and M.A., M.Sc., M.Com. courses during the Academic Session 2026–27.
- ii. Students taking admission in any professional, vocational and self-financing course shall not be eligible under this scheme unless otherwise instructed by Government.
- iii. In case of H.S., B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. and M.A./M.Sc./M.Com. courses, students whose fees were waived earlier shall also be eligible to avail the benefit of the scheme for subsequent year/semester admissions, subject to fulfilment of eligibility criteria and production of required documents.
- iv. Further, students enrolled in continuing semesters who could not submit valid income certificate at the time of entry-level admission but possess valid income certificate at the time of renewal/admission in the concerned semester may also be considered for the Fee Waiver Scheme, subject to due verification by the concerned Higher Educational Institution.

2. Institutes Incorporated under the Scheme

The Scheme shall be applicable to:

- i. All State Universities, Government Colleges, Autonomous Colleges, Government Model Colleges, Government Model Women Colleges, Pandit Deendayal Upadhyaya Adarsha Mahavidyalayas and Provincialised Colleges of Assam.
- ii. The Scheme shall not cover Private Colleges, Private Universities and Central Universities situated in Assam.

3. Applicability

The following categories of students shall be eligible under the Scheme:

- i. Students whose parental annual income is less than Rs. 4.00 lakh from all sources.
- ii. Students whose parents, either father or mother, are not employees of the State Government, Central Government, Semi-Government organisations, State Government undertakings or Central Government undertakings. However, provided that, where either or both parent of the student is employed as Grade-IV/MTS post under the State Government, Central Government, Semi-Government organisation, State Government undertaking or Central Government undertaking, the student may be considered eligible for the Fee Waiver Scheme, subject to fulfilment of all other prescribed eligibility conditions.
- iii. The student must be a permanent resident of Assam and must possess domicile of Assam in order to avail benefit under the Fee Waiver Scheme. The concerned Higher Educational Institution shall verify the residential/domicile status of the student through valid supporting documents as may be prescribed or notified by the Government.
- iv. To avail free admissions in the subsequent years, the attendance of the respective student should not be less than 70% in the academic year.
- v. Students who have arrears/backlogs in the previous academic year shall not be eligible to avail the Fee Waiver Scheme. Further, students who have not enrolled for the final examinations of the previous academic year shall also not be eligible to avail of the Fee Waiver Scheme.

- vi. Fee waiver will be revoked if any beneficiary student indulges in vandalism, ragging, misconduct, and anti-social activities, which may affect the academic atmosphere of the HEIs.

4. Proof of Income / Documents Required

- i. Ration Card issued by the competent authority shall be treated as the primary proof of income. The Ration Card must be issued by the competent authority of the State of Assam. Ration Cards issued by any other State shall not be accepted for claiming benefit under the Fee Waiver Scheme.
- ii. If the Ration Card is not available, only then will an income certificate issued by the concerned Revenue Circle Officer shall be accepted.
- iii. Applicants must possess a valid Aadhaar number and this information must be submitted along with a signed consent to the institution.
- iv. The College/University authority may grant admission to the student without examining the original marksheet at the time of admission. However, the admitted student must produce the original marksheet within the stipulated time, failing which the admission shall be liable to be cancelled.
- v. A declaration shall be obtained from the student stating that neither parent, father or mother, is an employee of the State Government, Central Government, Semi-Government organisation, State Government undertaking or Central Government undertaking. Such declaration form shall be devised by the concerned Registrar/Principal. If such declaration is found to be false, the admission under the Fee Waiver Scheme shall be cancelled and the admission fee shall be realised from the student.
- vi. If, however, either or both parents of a student are employed as Grade IV/Multi-Tasking Staff (MTS) under the State Government, Central Government, Semi-Government organisation, State Government undertaking or Central Government undertaking and fulfil the eligibility criteria prescribed above, the student shall submit a declaration in the prescribed format to that effect. Such declaration form shall be devised by the concerned Registrar/Principal.
- vii. The concerned Higher Educational Institution shall verify the authenticity of the documents submitted by the student before granting benefit under the Scheme.

5. Power of Admission Committees

- i. The Admission Committee of the concerned College or University shall have the power to enquire into the income status of the family in case of doubt regarding the claim of any student. If the Committee is of the view that the income of the parents exceeds Rs. 4.00 lakh per annum, it may recommend cancellation of the benefit under the Fee Waiver Scheme, notwithstanding the documents submitted by the student.
- ii. Such enquiry may be initiated suo motu by the Institution or on the basis of any complaint received against any student availing benefit under the Scheme.
- iii. Each Institution covered under the Scheme shall constitute an Admission Committee comprising senior faculty members of the Institution. The Principal/Registrar of the Higher Educational Institution shall exercise due diligence and shall ensure that no undeserving candidate is allowed to avail the benefit.
- iv. The Admission Committee shall have the discretion to check and verify the Ration Card, income certificate and other documents produced by applicants at the time of admission or renewal admission. In case of any doubt, the Institution may ask the candidate to produce further relevant documents to ascertain the validity of the claim.
- v. Only after being fully satisfied with the authenticity of the claim shall the Institution grant admission under the Fee Waiver category. If the Institution is not satisfied with the claim, the applicant shall be informed in writing with justification and admission may be granted under the non-fee waiver category, subject to fulfilment of other admission norms.
- vi. The Director of Higher Education, Assam may conduct random checks of documents uploaded in the portal or submitted in hard copy. Disciplinary action may be initiated against the student, official or Principal/Registrar, as applicable, in case of false claim, negligence or irregularity.

6. Fee to be Waived under the Scheme

The fees to be waived shall include all fees that a College or University normally realises from students in the regular course of admission, subject to the condition that the fee shall not exceed the normal course fee approved/realised for the previous academic session, unless otherwise approved by the Government.

The benefit shall be applicable as follows:

7. Responsibility of Colleges and Universities

- i. All Colleges and Universities shall upload the names and details of students admitted under the Fee Waiver Scheme in the Assam SAMARTH Portal or any other portal/system as notified by the Directorate of Higher Education, Assam.
- ii. The Registrars/Principals shall ensure that all student data uploaded in the portal are correct, complete and duly verified.
- iii. The concerned Higher Educational Institution shall maintain proper records of all students admitted under the Fee Waiver Scheme, including copies of Ration Card, income certificate, declaration and other relevant documents.
- iv. Higher Educational Institutions shall be required to collect and submit valid Aadhaar number of all students admitted under the Fee Waiver Scheme process, in the format and manner to be notified by the Directorate of Higher Education, Assam.
- v. The Higher Educational Institutions shall ensure that Aadhaar information submitted by students is correct, complete and properly recorded for the purpose of verification and processing of claims under the Fee Waiver Scheme.

8. Marking at the Reverse of Marksheet of Candidate Given Free Admission

- i. The Universities and Colleges granting free admission under this Scheme shall give an endorsement on the reverse of the relevant marksheet of the student so that the student does not seek free admission in multiple Institutions.
- ii. The Universities and Colleges shall devise a rubber seal and use the same on the reverse of marksheets of beneficiary students.
- iii. Where admission is processed fully through digital mode and physical endorsement on marksheet is not immediately feasible, the Institution shall maintain a digital record of such endorsement and ensure that duplicate benefit is not allowed.

9. Cancellation and Recovery

- i. If at any stage it is found that a student has availed benefit under the Fee Waiver Scheme by furnishing false information, false declaration, invalid document, ineligible Ration Card or by suppressing material facts, the benefit shall be cancelled.
- ii. In such cases, the applicable admission fee shall be realised from the student by the concerned Institution.
- iii. The Institution shall report such cases to the Directorate of Higher Education, Assam for further necessary action.

10. Reimbursement

- i. Reimbursement to the Higher Educational Institutions shall be subject to submission of correct and verified beneficiary data in the prescribed portal/format.
- ii. Reimbursement under the Fee Waiver Scheme shall be made to the Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) in respect of only those eligible students whose valid Aadhaar numbers have been submitted by the institution.
- iii. No reimbursement shall be admissible in respect of any student whose eligibility documents are found invalid or whose claim is found to be in violation of the provisions of this order.

The earlier orders, memoranda, corrigenda, clarifications or instructions issued on the aforesaid matter shall stand modified to the extent covered by this order.

OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Sub: Guidelines for providing Financial Assistance as Incentive to Girl Students under Mukhya Mantrir Nijut Moina Aasoni who are enrolled in Government Higher Educational Institutions under preview of Higher Education Department, including Central Universities, Venture Educational Institutions which are approved by the Government for inclusion under the Scheme and Polytechnic Institutions for Higher Secondary, Undergraduate (B.A./B.Sc./B.Com./ITEP), Post-Graduation (M.A./M.Sc./M.Com./B.Ed.) along with Self-Financed and Professional Courses, excluding Private Educational Institutions.

1. Background

The Hon'ble Finance Minister, Assam while presenting the Annual Budget for the financial year 2024-25 had announced in para 31 (I) of the Budget Speech 2024-25 that "10 lakh girls (one million- Nijut Moina) will be supported with financial grant as admission incentive to continue their education to higher secondary, graduation and post-graduation studies."

2. Objective of the Scheme:

- a) To increase the enrolment of girl students in Higher Education, thereby increasing the overall GER of the State.
- b) To increase the percentage of girls pursuing education beyond matriculation in Assam.
- c) To reduce dropouts among girl students.
- d) To eliminate the social evil of child marriage.

3. Scope of Applicability:

- a) Financial Assistance will be provided to girl students who are enrolled in Government and Venture Educational Institutions in Higher Secondary, Graduation (B.A./B.Sc./B.Com./ITEP), Post-Graduation (M.A./M.Sc./M.Com./B.Ed.) and Polytechnic Institutions, excluding those enrolled in Private Institutions. The incentive will be provided only to regular eligible female students. No arrear amount will be provided.
- b) The MMNMA beneficiaries are required to maintain discipline and adhere to all rules and regulations set forth by their respective institutes. This includes, but is not limited to, attending classes regularly, respecting institutional property, following the instructions of teachers and staff, and behaving respectfully towards peers and other personnel of the institute.
- c) Any violation of these rules, such as engaging in disruptive behaviour, cheating, ragging, vandalism, or any other form of misconduct, will result in withdrawal of the benefit under MMNMA.
- d) The girl students who receive a scooter as part of the Dr. Banikanta Kakati Merit Award under the Pragyan Bharati Scheme, which is being implemented by the Higher Education

Department, shall not be eligible for this scheme. If any girl opts out of receiving the scooter, she can apply for the Nijut Moina Scheme. However, this shall not apply to PG students.

4. EligibilityCriteria:

- a) The incentive is meant for all eligible girl students domiciled in Assam, irrespective of their economic status.
- b) Married girls will not be eligible for the scheme. However, married girls enrolled in P.G. and B.Ed. programmes shall be eligible.
- c) In-service girls admitted to the B.Ed. course on deputation will not be eligible for the scheme.
- d) Daughters of Ministers, MPs and MLAs are not eligible for the Nijut Moina Scheme.
- e) Postgraduate students availing the CM's Jibon Prerana Scheme shall not be eligible for this scheme.
- f) From the Academic Year 2027–28 onwards, girl students enrolled in H.S., U.G. and P.G. programmes shall be eligible to avail only the Fee Waiver Scheme or the Mukhya Mantrir Nijut Moina Aasoni. Beneficiaries shall not be eligible to avail both schemes.

5. Amount to be provided to each eligible girl student:

- a) Each eligible girl student enrolled in Higher Secondary shall receive an incentive of Rs. 800/- per month for a maximum period of ten months in an academic year.
- b) Each eligible girl student enrolled in Under Graduate Programmes shall receive an incentive of Rs. 1250/- per month for a maximum period of ten months in an academic year.
- c) Each eligible girl student enrolled in Post Graduate Programmes Graduation shall receive an incentive of Rs. 2500/- per month for a maximum period of ten months in an academic year.
- d) An incentive of Rs.800/- for 1st and 2nd Year and Rs. 1250/- for 3rd year per month shall be paid to each of the eligible girl students enrolled in Govt. Polytechnic Institutions for a maximum period of ten months in an academic year.
- e) No incentive will be paid during the summer vacation or winter break. The scheme shall not be effective during the months of June, July or during any other month as decided by the Government.

6. Mode of application:

- a) The students shall fill up the prescribed application form and submit the same to the respective institutions in which they are currently enrolled.
- b) Applicants must possess a valid Aadhaar number and must have an Aadhaar-seeded bank account, and this information must be submitted by the students to the Institution along with a signed consent & declaration form during the MMNMA application process. DBT will be done only through the Aadhaar-based payment system to the Aadhaar-seeded bank accounts of eligible girl students. No applicant will be eligible to receive benefit under the Scheme without a valid Aadhaar number and an Aadhaar-seeded bank account.
- c) The students shall ensure that the data provided by them is correct and complete.
- d) The Head of the Institutionshall ensure collection and verification of the application forms through their respectiveportals and submit the correct data in the portal.
- e) All Heads of Institutions shall notify One / Two Nodal Officers for implementing MMNM Aasoni in their respective institution.
- f) The guardians can choose as to whether their daughters optforavailing the benefits provided under MMNMA as some of them may not like to apply.

- g) The Heads of Institutions will intimate the concerned authorities if any student has opted out of the institution or becomes ineligible. They will also ensure that the beneficiaries attend classes regularly.
- h) Students who have not enrolled for the final examinations of the previous academic year shall also not be eligible to avail MMNMA benefits.
- i) For existing beneficiaries, the same conditions as above will apply. They will also submit a duly filled in application form with correct and complete details. The Head of the Institutions will ensure that the student has adhered to all the above conditions and has 70% attendance in the previous year.

7. Mode of payment:

- a) By monthly DBT only through Aadhaar-based payment system to the Aadhaar-seeded bank account of eligible girl student.

OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Sub: Guidelines for providing Financial Assistance to Male Students from economically weaker families under Mukhya Mantrir Nijut Babu Aasoni, who are enrolled in UG 1st and 2nd Years and PG 1st and 2nd Years in Government and Provincialised Higher Educational Institutions of Assam.

1. Background

The Government of Assam has launched several flagship welfare schemes to ensure equitable access to education and has introduced the Mukhya Mantrir Nijut Babu Aasoni to provide monthly financial assistance to male students to support their continuation in Higher Education studies. To ensure gender-balanced support and address dropout trends among economically vulnerable boys, the Higher Education Department is implementing the “Mukhya Mantrir Nijut Babu Aasoni”, providing DBT-based financial assistance to male students enrolled in UG 1st and 2nd Years and PG 1st and 2nd Years in Government and Provincialised Educational Institutions of Assam.

2. Objective of the Scheme:

- a) To increase enrolment of male students from economically weaker families in Higher Education, thereby improving the overall Gross Enrolment Ratio (GER) of the State.
- b) To increase the percentage of boys pursuing education beyond the Higher Secondary level in Assam.
- c) To reduce dropout rates among male students, particularly at the undergraduate and postgraduate entry levels.
- d) To provide support to male students so as to ensure gender parity, promote social equity and align with the goals of NEP 2020.

3. Scope of Applicability:

- a) Financial assistance shall be provided to eligible male students domiciled in Assam, who are enrolled in Undergraduate (UG) 1st and 2nd Years and Postgraduate (PG) 1st and 2nd Years in Government and Provincialised Educational Institutions, belonging to families with an annual income of less than ₹4 lakh and admitted under the Fee Waiver Scheme of the Government of Assam. The incentive shall be provided only to regular students. No arrear amount shall be admissible.
- b) Beneficiaries under the Mukhya Mantrir Nijut Babu Aasoni shall be required to maintain discipline and comply with all rules and regulations of their respective institutions, including regular attendance, academic conduct and respectful behaviour towards faculty, staff and fellow students.
- c) Any violation of institutional rules, including misconduct, indiscipline, cheating, ragging, vandalism or any other unacceptable behaviour, shall result in withdrawal of benefits under the scheme.

4. Eligibility Criteria:

- a) The incentive shall be applicable to male students domiciled in Assam, belonging to families with an annual income below Rs. 4.00 lakh and admitted under the Fee Waiver category.
- b) The student must be enrolled as a regular student in UG 1st and 2nd Years or PG 1st and 2nd Years in a Government or Provincialised Institution.
- c) In the case of UG male students, those who are married shall not be eligible for the scheme.
- d) In the case of UG male students, those who have opted for the Dr. Banikanta Kakati Merit Award (Scooter) shall not be eligible for the scheme.
- e) Postgraduate students availing the CM's Jibon Prerana Scheme shall not be eligible for this scheme.

5. Amount to be provided to each male student:

- a) Each eligible male student enrolled in Undergraduate 1st & 2nd Years shall receive an incentive of ₹1,000/- per month for a maximum period of ten (10) months per academic year.
- b) Each eligible male student enrolled in Postgraduate (PG) 1st & 2nd Years shall receive an incentive of ₹2,000/- per month for a maximum period of ten (10) months per academic year.
- c) No incentive will be paid during the summer vacation or winter break. The scheme shall not be effective during the months of June and July or during any other month as decided by the Government.

6. Mode of application:

- a) The students shall fill up the prescribed application form and submit the same to the respective institutions in which they are currently enrolled.
- b) Applicants must possess a valid Aadhaar number and must have an Aadhaar-seeded bank account, and this information must be submitted along with a signed consent & declaration form during the MMNBA application process. DBT will be done only through the Aadhaar-based payment system to the Aadhaar-seeded bank accounts of eligible girl students. No applicant will be eligible to receive benefit under the Scheme without a valid Aadhaar number and an Aadhaar-seeded bank account.
- c) The students shall ensure that the data provided by them is correct and complete.
- d) The Heads of the Institutions shall ensure collection and verification of the application forms through their respective portals and submit the correct data in the portal.
- e) All Heads of the Institutions shall ensure that only male students, admitted under fee-waiver scheme apply for the MMNB Aasoni. A valid income certificate from the competent authority or ration card of the parent of respective student is required for verification and upload.
- f) All Heads of Institutions shall notify One / Two Nodal Officers for implementing MMNBA Aasoni in their respective institution.
- g) The guardians can choose as to whether their sons will avail the benefits provided under the scheme.
- h) The Heads of Institutions will intimate the concerned authorities if any student has opted out of the institution or becomes ineligible. They will also ensure that the beneficiaries attend classes regularly.
- i) Students who have not enrolled for the final examinations of the previous academic year shall also not be eligible to avail MMNBA benefits.
- j) For existing beneficiaries, the same conditions as above will apply. They will also submit a duly filled in application form with correct and complete details. The Head of the Institutions will ensure that the student has adhered to all the above conditions and has 70% attendance in the previous year.

7. Mode of payment:

- a) By monthly DBT through Aadhaar-based payment system to the Aadhaar-seeded bank accounts of eligible male student.
